Attendees are placed into small syndicate groups for ongoing reflection sessions to explore the lessons learnt throughout the programme. Mentors (Group Facilitators) are young leaders who have recently completed RYLA. Current RYLA participants are encouraged to apply to be Mentors.

Each year the RYLA programme is unique – the participants make for a successful RYLA and the presenters and speakers offer different perspectives. The presenters come from all walks of life - Rotary and Community Sector Organisations, Corporate and Public Service Leaders, Sports People, Indigenous Leaders, Advocates and Refugees ...
